$username = "mrwdpetry";//replace with your user name!!!
$password = "";

$db_server = mysql_connect($host, $username, $password);
if (!$db_server) die("Unable to connect to MySQL: " . mysql_error());
mysql_select_db($dbname)
    or die("Unable to select database: " . mysql_error());
?>

PHP Catch and concatenate. (getsongs.php)

include("login.php");

$title = $_GET['Title'];
$sql = "Select * from songs where title='$title'";
echo $sql;

PHP Hit and Run

<?php
include("login.php");
$title = $_GET['Title'];

$songSql = "Select * from songs where title='$title'";

$results = mysql_query($songSql);
while($row = mysql_fetch_assoc($results)){
    echo $row['title'] . ' ' . $row['artist'] . "\n";
}
